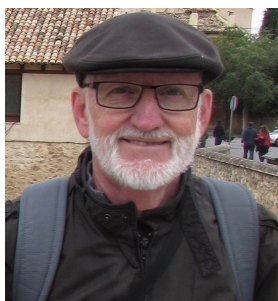

Harold Walkup is a signature member of the National Watercolor Society, the Northwest Watercolor Society and the Western Federation of Watercolor Societies. He has been a popular juror and workshop teacher for the past 35 years.

His works are in public and private collections throughout the U.S. and in Russia, Spain and South America. Walkup's paintings have received many national and regional awards, including The Grumbacher Silver Medal; Watercolor Society of Oregon Best of Show; and recent 2nd and 5th places in the Northwest Watercolor Society exhibitions in Seattle, Washington.

Walkup's paintings have been featured in many books, including Northlight Publishing's *Splash 4*, *Best of Watercolor II*, and *Best of Color: Painting Color*. Nita Leland's new book *Exploring Color Workshop* includes three of his works.
