Paint: Students may bring their own preferred palette of watercolors or choose whether to purchase new paint – each student should have a warm & cool of each of the primary colors & secondary colors

Trish will bring a limited amount of QoR watercolor paint for students to sample & try

Basic Supplies: large water container, water spray bottle, paper towels, blow dryer, 1" white artist tape, 4-6 large bull clips, 2B pencil, kneaded eraser, rubbing alcohol, favorite sketchbook – any size, to work out ideas, & 2-3 mounting boards for watercolor paper – boards should be slightly larger than full size 22x30 watercolor sheet– Trish prefers Masonite or Corrugated Plastic Sign Board – *plastic sign board can be purchased in large sheets & cut to size @ Lowes or found in a variety of other places – ie, Michael's, Amazon, or local art supply store*

Paper: 3-5 sheets - 22"x30" Arches 140lb Cold Press Watercolor Paper

Brushes: Round: #12, #14, & (optional #3 or #4 for details) & Flat: ½", 1" or 2" - Gold or White Talkon

Trish prefers & uses: #14 Long Round, Princeton Velvetouch (3950LR) - #4 Quill, Princeton Neptune Series 4750 Synthetic Squirrel

Creative Ephemera:

4-8 Reference Photos - suggestions & criteria for photos...

- photos that are personally meaningful or have a hidden, subtle story meaningful to you
- photos can be any subject matter, provided the subject is something that the student is familiar with & painted before
- photos with simple, close up, & graphic compositions with a strong, definite light source will work the best
- print photos out as large as you can on your home printer – ie, 8.5x11

Words – once Reference Photos are selected, *begin to Weave Your Story* – ie, Favorite Poetry, Quotes, Song Lyrics, Uplifting Words, Scan & Copy Journal Passages, Handwritten Notes, etc...print words out on your regular inkjet home printer, 8.5x11 on regular copy paper, & bring with you to class

Trish will bring.... reference photos, mixed media & extra watercolor brushes, GOLDEN, matte medium & gesso, creative ephemera – ie, words to collage, mark-making tools, & stencils, inspirational books, - & much more!
