## Supplies needed:

I will bring watercolor pencils of basic colors only, a small bit of water and one brush to enliven the colors. I generally use a black ink pen for my sketching.

**Clothing:** wear the clothing that a will suit the weather we may have which can include rain, cool to warm temps and comfortable walking shoes plus a necessary hat and jacket.

**Equipment:** Most important will be a *chair*, so that you can sit and sketch quickly and comfortably, keeping the googling public at some sort of distance. Keep your supplies to a minimum as we will stop several times on our walk to the waterfront park and you will not want armloads of loose supplies. We will stop a few times on our way to the waterfront. I like to allow enough time to sketch the beautiful 19c architecture along the way, perhaps an interesting archway, alley or tree lined street view. The Carousel Park has many interesting subjects aside from groups of people in a landscape: riverboat, bridge, carousel and activity.

**Art supplies:** sketch book, drawing implement of your choice (felt tips, pencils, some watercolors if you like but w/c pencils are easier to manage when moving often), and water for your body as well as for your rapid sketching.

We will have a short sharing/critique at the conclusion of our sketching visit. And yes, I will do some demonstrating and mostly visiting with you privately as you sketch your favorite subjects. It is a group experience as well as a private one.
