

When I selected work for the exhibition and judged the accepted pieces for awards, I looked objectively for strong design and evidence of technical skill. On a more subjective and intuitive level, I looked for paintings that had something to say - paintings that struck an emotional chord. Technique is crucial but it is not enough to


